Second Public Hearing 2015 Community Development Block Grant Program
Township Engineer Jason Worth reported this program is federally funded through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development administered through the Ocean County Planning Department. The goal is to benefit low to moderate income residents. In the past, projects have included handicap accessible doors, handicap ramps, sidewalks and things of this nature. Based on the first public hearing, we reached out to the county regarding possible roof replacement at 7 Gifford Lane. After several discussions, the county indicated that project is not viewed positively because it is not located in a designated target neighborhood and will not benefit low to moderate income residents. Based on needs of the township at this time we would recommend the governing body move forward with the drainage application for roadway improvements on East Hudson Drive. There are some issues in that area and it would be a high ranking project from the counties objective list. We are recommending submitting an application in the amount of \$60,000.00.
