

## **Public Notice**

Township of Little Egg Harbor  
Ocean County, New Jersey  
Twin Lakes Boulevard Drainage Improvements  
State Project No. S344060-02

In accordance with procedures established to evaluate projects that have applied for assistance under the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program (EIFP), a Level 1 environmental review has been conducted on the proposed project, which will involve drainage improvements to the Township's existing municipal stormwater collection system located along Twin Lakes Boulevard. Specifically, under the proposed project, the Township will remove the existing stormwater drainage collection system, which consists of approximately 6,826 linear feet of drainage pipe, 83 inlets, 4 manholes, and 290 linear feet of bulkhead at 13 outfall locations. The Township will replace the above items with a new reconfigured stormwater drainage collection system, which will consist of approximately 8,915 linear feet of new drainage pipe, 112 new inlets, 4 new manholes, 12 new inline check valves, 290 linear feet of new bulkhead at 13 outfall locations, and the restoration of paved and un-paved areas. The results of this project will minimize stormwater flooding that is negatively affecting the water quality in nearby waterways and improve traffic access to and from homes during storm events.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has made a preliminary decision to assist this project under the EIFP. The proposed project costs are as follows:
