Planning Board: As per George Garbaravage a three (3) lot subdivision by David Schlick was approved and the diesel fuel tanks were approved to be put in at Wawa Rt 539 site.

Pinelands Municipal Council: Bill Armitage nothing to report at this time.

NJ Futures: Robert Burr reported on NFWF Marsh and Wetland Replenishment Project monthly conference call on November 13, 2015. Overall, Project has slowed with the NJDEP review of samples from proposed dredging areas. Project met with the American Littoral Society for insight and recommendations associated with the Society's similar NFWF projects along the Delaware River. Project noted recent meetings with local towns to get input. Lastly, the Project working to identify additional dredging areas with sandy material more suitable for marsh restoration and living shoreline development.

Quality of Life Issues: Donna to contact Lt Hart who is in charge of COP's in reference the current work they are doing regarding portable pots and trash containers.

Meetings dates were reviewed and August and November will be no meeting. Motion to approve by Walt Doherty, second by George Garbaravage, all members in favor.

Committeeman Kobryn advises that he will bringing up the Master Plan at next Township Meeting to discuss Township centers.
