

# The Sandy Relief Fund for Home Repair and Advocacy Program

The Ocean County Board of Social Services received \$1.8M and is administering a new program called the Home Repair and Advocacy Program (HRAP) effective January 22, 2014. Eligibility and Contact information is as follows:

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- Resident of Ocean County
- Seniors, age 60 and over or disabled (verification required)
- Sustained damage or loss as a result of Superstorm Sandy and still need repair (program will not reimburse for work already done)
- Must be homeowner
- Must be primary residence
- Provide documentation of application to FEMA or public/private insurance and amounts received
- Anyone who did not apply to FEMA will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis
- \$5,000 per household cap
