## Latex, Oil, Boat & Spray Paint

Accepted Daily Mon-Sat 7:30 am to 3 pm Special Waste Drop-off at Northern & Southern Recycling Centers



#### No need to wait for a Household Hazardous Waste event!

20 gallons per day per person. NO stains, polyurethanes or varnishes (take to Household Hazardous Waste events).

Dried up paint can be disposed with regular trash

## **Brush & Leaves Disposal**

Northern (NRC) 535 South Oberlin Avenue, Lakewood, NJ Southern (SRC) 379 Haywood Rd. Manahawkin, NJ



Brush Less than 4 inch diameter **Leaves** Unbagged Leaves ONLY

No weeds or invasive species (bamboo, or anything with roots).

Many municipal sites offer this service, contact your DPW.

### **Free Garden Products**



#### **Finished Leaf Compost**

A great choice for intensively planted flower, shrub and vegetable beds. Compost adds organic matter back to the soil faster than mulch. Ideal to use during Spring.




#### **Single Ground Mulch**

Excellent for walkways or garden beds, great weed suppression and moisture retention.

#### **Double Ground Mulch**

Perfect for garden beds, finer mulch.



## What to do with

#### **Button (Coin) Batteries**

Used for Hearing Aids, Glucose Meter, Thermometers, Scales & other devices.



Tape the ends before dropping off at Northern (NRC) 601 New Hampshire Ave. Lakewood Southern (SRC) 379 Haywood Rd. Stafford Mon-Sat from 7:30 am to 3:00 pm.

## How to get rid of

#### **Appliances**

Dispose of non-working appliances as scrap metal.

#### Bags (Reusable)

Excess bags in good condition can be donated to food pantries. To find a location near you visit cfbnj.org/donate-reusable-shopping-bags

Damaged bags can be disposed of as textile waste. Find a location by visiting helpsy.co/find-a-bin

#### **Bulky Waste (Furniture) & Construction**

- 1. Donate or sell-items in good condition

  Habitat for Humanity will pick up 2 or more items for free nohfh.com/restore
- 2. Some municipalities offer bulk pick-up.
- 3. Ocean County Landfill.

#### Flags

If you'd like assistance on proper flag disposal contact your local VFW (The Veterans of Foreign Wars) or the American Legion, find a drop off near you at their website.

#### **Helium Tanks**

Please ensure the tank is completely empty, you can follow the manufacturer's instructions for disposal visit balloontime.com/resources/recycle-or-store/

Once tank is ready for disposal, please take it to a scrap metal location near you. See page 13 for a list of places in Ocean County.

### Unwanted Items

#### **Mattresses**

Dispose with bulk waste, contact yout local DPW.

#### Plastic bags, film, and wrap
